Asalaam Alaikum Dear Parents,

Alhamdulillah, by the grace of Allah, we have completed the month of October without any Covid cases amongst our teachers or students. We ask Allah to protect all of us from harm. I ask all parents to continue to be diligent by filling out the SMS App Daily Check every day without fail. We have noticed that some parents send their children to school when they are not fully recovered from sickness. Please do not do this as we will isolate your child in our First Aid room and call you to pick up him/her up. It is not easy for any parents who work, but this is the proper procedure and will help us control the spread of any sicknesses. Allah willing, your diligence, coupled with our protocols, will help keep our staff and students safe and secure.

Sugar-Free November:

We ask that all parents comply with this initiative and not send any sugary treats or snacks during November. In fact, I am hoping that parents join us in this challenge and embrace this initiative in their homes. The teachers, administration, and of course the principal, will also give up sugar in November.

Interim Report Cards:

You should have received Interim Progress Reports from our teachers on Monday. This is not an official report card; however, its purpose is to provide a snapshot of how your child is doing thus far. Our teachers will be conducting inperson interviews with all of you starting this Thursday and Friday. Please book your appointments via the link sent through the SMS App. It is a new, fast, and easy procedure that we are adding this year.

November Activities:

November will feature a Spelling Bee for Grades 3 to 8. The teachers will administer the testing in their classes, and the final three students from each class will compete in the Gym at the end of the month. This activity is optional for all students. We want to enrich our students' year, without adding any pressure on them. The Arabic Bee will also be a part of our November campaign. It will follow the same format.

Principal's Message

Travel during the year.

I am also noticing many requests to travel overseas during the school year. Please understand that the school discourages students from missing school for any extended period, even if the work is taken and completed during the trip. The government does not support us for 'distance learning.' If your children travel, they will be given the basic workbooks, but the report card will reflect the student(s) absence and minimal assessment. I do empathize and understand the need for families to travel, but the government does not make allowances and penalizes us for long-term absences.

Social media and online activity.

I would like all of you to be very careful with your children's online activity and screen time at home. We parents are allowing our children to connect with other students, and family members via social media, unsupervised. It may seem harmless, but we are learning about many problems involving profanity, inappropriate discussions between boys and girls, and cyberbullying as well. While we do our best to control these issues in school, we cannot control what the students do on their devices in their homes. That is the responsibility of all parents. Ultimately, parents need to check, monitor, and guide their children when they use Discord, Snapchat, You Tube, Online Gaming, Instagram, Tik Tok, and more.

On a connected note, please be aware that students in the older grades may be watching a show called "Squid Game" on Netflix which is rated mature and not for viewers under 17 due to profanity/swearing, inappropriate scenes and extreme violence which is used to entertain people in the movie. Concerns about the effects of this show are being raised all around the world, especially as kids as young as 6, have been acting out the violent scenes. Netflix in general has many "mature" shows that are inappropriate for adults, let alone kids. However, some students have unlimited access to all these shows at home, and we all need to take measures to ensure that they are not accessing Islamically inappropriate shows on any devices! InshaAllah, we will set up parent workshops at our school shortly to deal with such topics soon.

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

Lockdown Drill

Responsibility is one of the most key aspects of Islam. Everybody is responsible for doing such actions. Allah did not create us without any purpose.


